

PART THREE – SITE SPECIFIC GEOGRAPHIC RESPONSE STRATEGIES

COOK INLET GEOGRAPHIC RESPONSE ZONES

The Cook Inlet Subarea has been divided into seven response zones for the purpose of GRS development. Figure G-3-1 delineates the boundaries for each GRS response zone.

The Geographic Response Strategies presented in this section are organized by response zone, starting with Northern Cook Inlet. As of June 2004, this section contains GRS for the Central Cook Inlet, Kachemak Bay, Northern Cook Inlet, Seward, and Southwestern Cook Inlet Zones. As additional GRS are developed for these and other Cook Inlet zones, they will be included here as subsections, in the following order:

- A. Central Cook Inlet Zone
- B. Kachemak Bay Zone
- C. Northern Cook Inlet Zone
- D. Seward Zone
- E. Southwestern Cook Inlet Zone
- F. Southeastern Cook Inlet Zone
- G. Whittier Zone

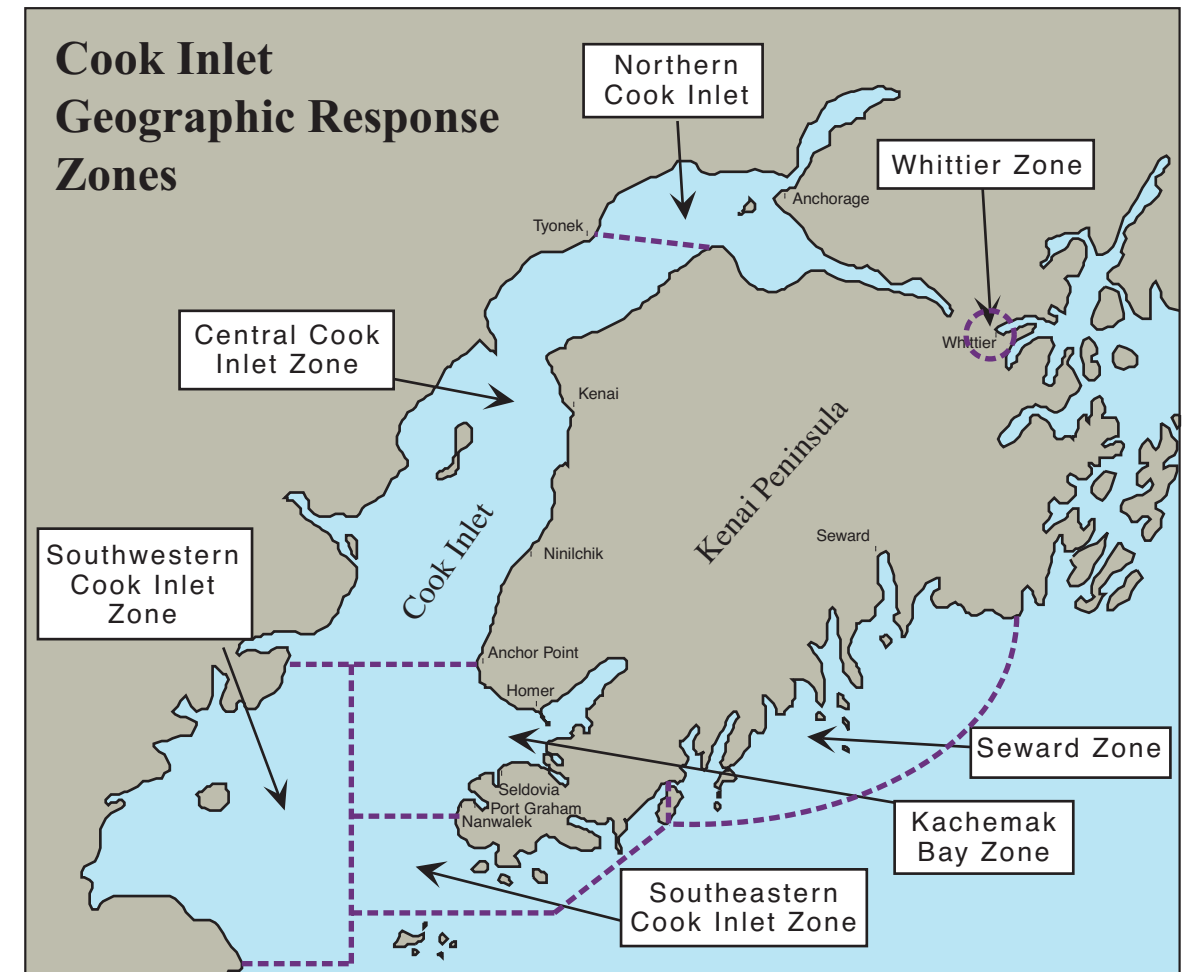


Figure G-3-1. Cook Inlet Geographic Response Zones.
