

## DMVA Comments for Change 3 to the Unified Plan

1. Page A-48, Para I .a. – Add section “(7) Determines if a Federal Disaster Declaration is warranted. If so, forwards a request for a Federal Disaster Declaration to the Federal Emergency Management Agency for processing.”
2. Page A-53, Para c. – Add section at the end listing DES authorities as AS 26.23, Alaska Disaster Act.
3. Page A-57, Para g.(12) – permitting and weigh stations are usually a responsibility of DOT vice DCED.
4. Page E-37, Tab T – please update with the following changes:

5. Page E-38, Tab V – Change title to read: “RRT and OSC ACCESS TO EMERGENCY COMMUNICATIONS.” Line 3, change Broadcast to “Alert” and (EBS) to “(EAS)”. Para a., line 7 – the NWS number has been changed, please call NWS to determine what the current number is. Para a., line 17 – Change Broadcast to “Alert”. Para b. – Recommend deletion of the last sentence beginning with “Because the Alaska...” Para c., Line 3 – change the number 23 to “28”.
  6. Page E-47, Para d. – Change six to “five” PSTs. Add, “ADMVA/DES has 15 Iridium portable satellite phones and three Globalstar portable satellite phones available for deployment.” Para e., Add – “The Alaska State Troopers have a communications trailer available. The 103<sup>rd</sup> Civil Support Team (Alaska National Guard) has a communications van available for use in special situations.”

7. Page E-59, Para (4) – Add, “DES has 2 hand-held ground-air radios available for deployment.” Para (5) – Add, “DES has 2 hand-held marine radios available for deployment.” Para 6. – Recommend deletion of the entire paragraph as the C/KU band systems are not operational and DES does not have funding to upgrade to current standards.
  
8. Page H-18, Training Guidelines for LEPCs – based on a phone conversation with Tom Wells, Chair of the SERC Training Committee, these training guidelines only need some minor updates to be current. Recommend this update be tasked at the next SERC meeting and included in the final version of Change 3.
